

INSTRUCTIONS / GUIDELINES OF COUNSELING FOR ADMISION INTO M.SC (APPLIED NUTRITION) & (SPORTS NUTRITION) AT ICMR-NIN, HYDERABAD

- Candidates appeared for N-CET 2022 held on 16th July 2022 are requested to check the results of N-CET 2022 uploaded on the ICMR-NIN (www.nin.res.in)
- Candidates are suggested to keep ready the **SCANNED COPIES OF CERTIFICATES FOR UPLOADING** as and when announced in the website (www.nin.res.in) (list of certificates given below)
- **Central Quota Seats** : Candidates belonging to states **other than** Telangana and Andhra Pradesh.
- **State Quota Seats** : Candidates belonging to Telangana and Andhra Pradesh states

- Web option (after certificate verification) is to be exercised only by candidates who are eligible for both M.Sc.(Applied Nutrition) and M.Sc. (Sports Nutrition).
- A provisional merit list would be displayed on ICMR-NIN website after certificate verification
- Classes are expected to be commenced from September/October 2022
- **HOWEVER, ACCOMMODATION (INSIDE THE COLLEGE CAMPUS) TO ADMITTED CANDIDATES FROM OUTSIDE HYDERABAD WILL BE PROVIDED FROM JANUARY 2023 ONLY.**

- **Original Bonafide Study Certificates from 9th to qualifying examination.**
- **Original X class or equivalent certificate.**
- **Original Marks sheet of intermediate/class XII**
- **Provisional or Original Degree Certificate of qualifying exam**
- **Marks sheets of all years / all semesters of qualifying degree exam**
- **Original Migration Certificate issued by the concerned university where last studied.**
- **OBC Non-creamy layer certificate for Central Quota, if applicable**
- **Community, Nativity and Date of Birth Certificate for S.C/S.T./B.C., candidates as per G.O.M.S. No. 58 Social Welfare (J) Department dated 12-5-1997, if applicable**
- **Service Certificate and No-objection Certificate from the employer, in case of employed candidates.**
- **Income and Asset certificate for the seat under Economically Weaker Section (EWS) if applicable, in prescribed format.**

- Study Certificate from VI to XII/ Diploma (To establish local area of the candidate) in case of candidate with institutionalized education.
- Residence Certificate of candidate for a period of 7 years preceding to qualifying examination in case where the candidate has no institutionalized education.
- In respect of Non-Local candidates in order to consider them for allotment under unreserved seats the following certificates needs to be submitted:-
Residence Certificate: Candidate who has resided in the State for a total period of 10 years excluding periods of study outside the State; or either of whose parents have resided in the State for a total period of 10 years excluding periods of employment outside the State.
