

- 1. Scope: To be used by health care workersreturning homeafter surveillance activities in the containment zones/Survey areas
- 2. **Purpose:** This document describes information about what precautions need to be taken on reaching home after surveillanceactivities in the containment zones/Survey areas

3. Responsibilities:

- Appropriate measures to be taken after surveillance on reaching home
- 4. Return to homeafter surveillance activities
 - Once back from the survey, leave footwear outside of the home
 - Backpacks with hospital usage materials to be stored at dedicated room
 - No hugs to kids or other family members is advised
 - Do not touch door handles orany other item immediately in the house.
 - Proceed for hot shower and soap bath immediately
 - Clothes and other reusable masks/other items to be dumped/soaked immediately in disinfectant hot water for 1 hour atleast and then washed.
 - Disinfect your mobile, wrist watch, ornaments, etc.
- 5. Hydroxychloroquine (HCQ) tablet may be used as prophylactic agent in asymptomatic front line workers as per latest ICMR guidelines.
- 6. In case, any field surveillance worker becomes symptomatic (fever, cough, breathing difficulty) within 14 days after survey, they should inform Director, get tested and follow standard protocol as per National/ICMR guidelines.
- 7. Self monitoring by health care workers for a period of 14 days after last potential exposure to be done. No exclusion from duty needed.
