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INTERNATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAMME

A one-week International training course on 'Production, management and use of food composition data in nutrition' – FOODCOMP 2024 Organised by South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation (SAARC) FOODS Regional Centre in association with ICMR-NIN held from 19th – 24th February. 24 participants from 13 countries took part in the training programme. NUTRIAIDE-APP LAUNCHED

The NutriAIDE-App (Beta Version), developed as a component of the ongoing Indo-German project "NutriAIDE-Building smart food environments for improved nutrition", was officially launched by Dr.Hemalatha, Director of ICMR-NIN, in the presence of Prof. Markus Keck from Universität Augsburg, along with other researchers from the Wuppertal Institute for Climate, Environment, and Energy and the German Institute of Human Nutrition.
