The INFUSE Summit 2025, successfully organized by the ICMR-NIN and held from 4th– 5th December 2025, brought together innovators, researchers, and public health professionals from across the country to showcase cutting-edge solutions in nutrition and food systems.

The Summit was inaugurated by Dr. Bharati Kulkarni, Director, ICMR-NIN and Dr. Rajiv Bahl, DG, ICMR, & Secretary, DHR, addressed the gathering virtually, emphasizing the importance of innovation-driven approaches for strengthening public health nutrition in India.

From over 150 applications received nationwide, 33 promising innovations were short-listed and presented across key thematic areas including food technology, micronutrient assessment, precision nutrition, and point-of-care diagnostics. The event fostered meaningful dialogue and collaboration, reinforcing ICMR-NIN's leadership in advancing innovation to improve public health nutrition outcomes.

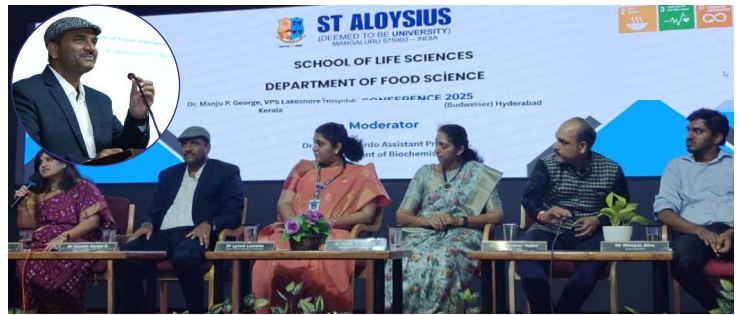
